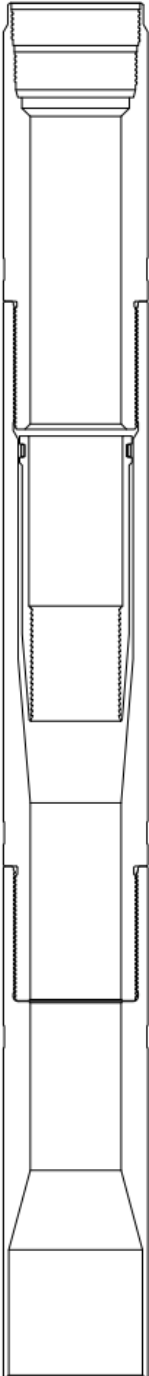




Continuous Coiled Tubing Overshot



The Continuous Coiled Tubing Overshot is used to retrieve continuous tubing strings that have been parted, stuck, and/or abandoned in the wellbore. The overshot is attached to the desired fishing string, then lowered to the top of the fish, maintaining circulation and washover to the required depth. Lifting the work string will cause the overshot grapple to engage the coil tubing. Retrieval operations of the tubing string can now begin. The overshot guide may also be dressed with carbide to aid in washing over or dressing the top of the coil tubing. A pack-off sub can also be run with the overshot to permit circulation through the tubing string.
