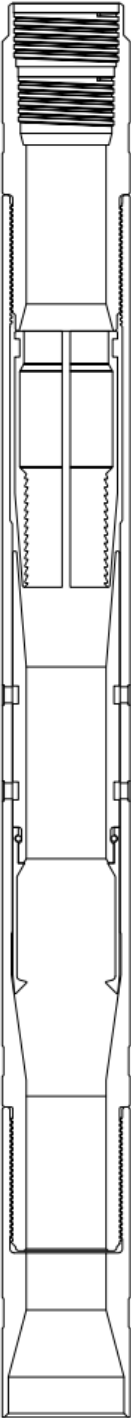




Continuous Cutting Coil Overshot



The Continuous Cutting Coil Overshot is a tool that can be used to strip over a coiled tubing fish, and then cut the coiled tubing fish by applying an over pull to the fish. The coiled tubing fish that has been cut off, can then be retrieved out of the well bore with the same assembly.

The tool is emplaced on the bottom of the fishing string that is used to convey the tool to the top of the coiled tubing fish in the well bore. The tool is then rotated, slowly, to get over the coiled tubing fish. Then the Continuous Cutting Coil Overshot is stripped over the fish to the desired point where the fish is to be cut. An over pull is applied to the fish, allowing the overshot's cutting grapple to engage and then start to shear through the pipe, causing a weak point to where the fish will part.
